Near the southern end of Virginia Beach, just minutes from the Atlantic Ocean, you'll come to Indian Cove Resort, a private, gated Coast Deluxe property. The family-friendly 66-acre haven welcomes RVers to hundreds of tree-shaded full-hookup sites along freshwater canals.

"The location gets a 10," posts one online reviewer about Indian Cove. Another calls his Indian Cove campsite "the best I have ever been to."

Indian Cove has been greeting happy campers since 1981 with its large clubhouse, paved roads and four covered pavilions that host a wide range of activities. Families get to know each other at the community fire pit, where folks gather nightly for campfires and cookouts.

In addition to fishing for large-mouth bass, speckled perch and channel catfish, you can borrow kayaks,

pedal boats and canoes, free of charge, to navigate the surrounding waters. Kids flock to the resort's two playgrounds, and teens congregate at the on-site skate park.

A busy slate of activities, from Satur-

day dances to potluck dinners to theme weekends, are another reason Woodall's rated Indian Cove five out of five Diamond-W's for Recreation.

Stroll around the resort grounds and you'll find an impressive three



swimming pools, four bathhouses, tennis courts, horseshoe pits and a boat-launch ramp. In recent years, renovations have been made to the pools, bathhouses and adult lounge, the buildings have been repainted, and the poolside chairs and tables have been replaced.

Indian Cove's convenient laundry room and general store—with an ATM, firewood and propane—mean you don't need to leave the resort except to find more fun. Make time to strut down the Virginia Beach boardwalk, frolic on the wide-open shores and take a dip in the sparkling sea. As you pass through the gates to return to the resort, give a friendly wave to one of the round-the-clock security guards.
