On the eastern slope of the Blue Ridge Mountains near Shenandoah National Park and scenic Skyline Drive, Shenandoah Crossing has scenery to rival its lofty neighbors. Picture a gracious Southern estate with a thousand acres of forests, hills, pastures and a shimmering lake.

Rated five Diamond-W's for both Facilities and Recreation, this central Virginia Coast Deluxe Resort has nonstop activities and a long list of upscale amenities, from an equestrian center to an 18-hole golf course to a new splash zone for kids. There's even an outdoor chessboard with 4-foot-tall game pieces.

Guests can saddle up for a trail ride along miles of horse paths or go fishing in 60-acre Lake Izac. Take advantage of the lake's free pedal boats, rent a kayak or have a party on a pontoon boat. Then

get to know your fellow guests in a friendly game of horseshoes, basketball, tennis or volleyball. The lighted and beautifully landscaped mini-golf course lets you putt for glory, even after dark.

Resort guests can grab a meal at the tavern in the lodge or the deli in the general store. When it's time to unwind, head to the sauna, hot tubs and indoor and outdoor pools. But don't get too relaxed or you'll miss the lakeside bonfire.



To find out what's going on at the resort and in the surrounding area, stop by the activities office in the lodge. Thomas Jefferson's home, Monticello, awaits just down the road, and many of Virginia's historically significant sites are within easy driving distance.

RV sites range from picnic tables and fire rings at the original campground to state-of-the-art in the newer RV area. Enhanced sites include a grill, patio furniture, pull-through access and an outdoor kitchen. The high-end Presidential site goes above and beyond with an arbor-screened private hot tub.

For those without an RV, Shenandoah Crossing rents chalets, cabins and lavishly furnished yurts as well as the historic manor house and rooms in the lodge. Contact the resort directly to make lodging reservations.
