Head to the country store for fishing and camping supplies as well as snow cones, popcorn, nachos and other goodies. The Bass Lake Café serves up large portions of homemade dishes and desserts and has a liquor license to boot.

What's new at Bass Lake? The installation of Wi-Fi, for starters, and air conditioning in the café and adult clubhouse. One of the pools received a high-tech resurfacing, and the other got a new water flume slide that's a big hit with the kids. Owners Fabian and Shawn Russell are constantly sprucing up the place, and now they're on a mission to add 50 RV sites and upgrade the electrical system.

“Sure we have a beautiful lake, a clean facility, plenty of things to do and a friendly and helpful staff,” proclaim the Russells on their website. “But we like to think of it as an opportunity to bring people together.”
