Don't be fooled by the northern address of Bridgeview RV Resort—Lethbridge, Alberta. A stay there doesn't mean you're exposed to the frozen north. The resort is situated in a picturesque river valley on the westerly outskirts of Lethbridge. The resort got its name from the fact the Lethbridge Viaduct, commonly known as the High Level Bridge, is located within sight of the resort. It's the longest and highest steel trestle bridge in North America. Running under the bridge is the Oldman River—a perfect place for boating and fishing for many varieties of trout, mountain whitefish, pike, walleye, and sturgeon.

Enjoy swimming in the pool at the resort and activities such as weekly dances and pancake breakfasts. Bridgeview RV Resort features include a new playground, a special dog

area, an onsite general store with a bistro atmosphere, and exercise and game rooms.

"In addition to the location near lots of activities, guests will be impressed with how well laid out the resort is. It's well groomed," says George Goddard, general manager.

"We have an area that we class as 'Wilderness' for folks who like to have bigger sites and be further away from their neighbors."
