There's nothing scary about this pristine mountain resort

In the Sierra Mountains, nestled among tall pines at the gateway to South Lake Tahoe, is the beautiful Ghost Mountain Ranch Resort in Pollock Pines, California. This resort was once the set of the popular TV series, "The Virginian." Ramble through the vintage ghost town complete with a saloon, ice cream parlor, and general store.

Once you pull your rig into this 350-acre preserve, you'll see that the spacious campsites and rental cabins are surrounded by miles of hiking trails and streams to explore. Bring your fishing gear and cast a line into the resort's stocked fishing pond. The areas surrounding the resort have dozens of trails and hundreds of square miles to explore by horseback. Hiking in the Sierras is a trail hiker's dream come true.

"Ghost Mountain Ranch Resort sits at about 4,000-foot elevation and is halfway between South Lake Tahoe and Sacramento," says Randy Wright, Director of Research and Development. "It sits at the snow line and we can either get just missed or get a foot of snow. The resort sits in the midst of tall pines."

Relax in the large, crystal clear swimming pool with a seasonal snack bar or meet old and new friends at the clubhouse. Let your kids or grandkids join the Kids Club where they will be entertained and taught crafts.

Saddle up your horses because Ghost Mountain Ranch has safe and clean corrals on the property as well as miles of trails to explore. Or, if you prefer, practice your tricks or teach your new riders in the Rodeo Arena.

Fill your days with activities at the pool, fishing at the pond, or hiking in the woods. Then spend your evening visiting South Lake Tahoe, where you can enjoy skiing, boating, bike trails, blackjack, or ice skating.
