Combine golf, clean air, and a pretty “fair view”

The nearby town of Fairview was originally named North Bend, but in 1864 it forsook its original name in favor of the more descriptive name Fairview because of the excellent view south toward the Manti-La Sal National Forest. So, when you pull your rig into Skyline Mountain Resort in Fairview, Utah, plan on seeing great views of the area. But there’s more.

Don’t forget your golf clubs to play on the lovely 9-hole golf course and practice on the driving range. And it’s a busy course with frequent golf tournaments such as the Food Bank Golf Tournament, Home Plate Mixed Couples Tournament, and El Mexicano Senior Men’s Scramble. At the Golf Shack you can rent a cart or clubs and purchase range balls.

Skyline Mountain Resort is located on the outskirts of Fairview, 95 miles south of Salt Lake City. The beautiful resort occupies 1,500 acres along the crystal mountain stream of Birch Creek. Outdoor recreation includes cross-country skiing, snowmobiling, hiking, horseback riding, and fishing, with five lakes nearby.

The Skyline Cross Country Ski Club maintains a beautiful,

groomed cross-country ski trail on the golf course during the winter.

Other amenities include a swimming pool with waterslide (there is a charge for pool use). Also enjoy spotless restrooms and showers, ice, dump station, and gravel and cement sites with picnic tables. Exercise on the tennis courts and hiking trails. Pets are welcome on leash.

Fairview is the gateway to the famous Skyline Drive, a 75-mile scenic 4X4 mountain road that offers hundreds of miles of outdoor recreational opportunities.

Nearby, visit the Fairview Museum of History and Art, which contains historical collections and the works of sculptor Avard T. Fairbanks, regional art, historical displays, and a Clark Bronson bronze collection.

The Huntington-Eccles Scenic Byway begins in Fairview, Utah. The drive heads east up the canyon on Highway 31 through the Manti-La Sal National Forest.
