

# WILDERNESS VILLAGE



## Set in a beautiful forest two hours from Calgary

Wilderness Village at Crimson Lake in Rocky Mountain House, Alberta, is considered the gateway to the west country including the majestic Rocky Mountains. The resort is located on a quarter section of land (160 acres) and has 11 rental cabins and hundreds of large, serviced RV sites, each with a fire pit and picnic table.

You may just want to relax at your spacious RV site, but you can also get involved in many other ways. Take a dip in one of the two swimming pools or three hot tubs. Your children or grandchildren will love the various playgrounds and the petting zoo. Forgot salt? No worries. A seasonal village convenience store is stocked and also has a concession stand. Plus, firewood is complimentary.

Wilderness Village at Crimson Lake is well known for its trail-ride operation. Western and English-style horseback riding lessons are available for adults and children. Sign up for a trail ride for varying lengths of time. An all-day ride includes a steak fry supper. Or if you're feeling energetic, sign up for an overnight pack trip.

The resort management is enthusiastic about families and the need for families to participate in recreational activities. They suggest exploring hiking trails that lead to beaver dams or fishing in one of the nearby lakes or streams

The area surrounding Wilderness Village is packed with things to do. Nearby Crimson Lake features 12 miles of graveled trails for hiking, mountain biking and cross-country skiing in the winter. The Amerada Trail encircles the lake. There's boating, water skiing, windsurfing, canoeing, and swimming.

Cow Lake, just minutes southwest of Rocky Mountain House, offers swimming, boating, fishing and a chance to relax at a sandy beach or sit by a crackling fire in a peaceful setting. An extensive walking trail runs north of the lake through an evergreen forest.
