Indian Cove Resort in Virginia Beach, Virginia has the best of both worlds—two minutes from the Atlantic Ocean and bordering a freshwater channel that leads to the wildlife refuge at Back Bay. The bay is famous for its largemouth bass, speckled perch, and channel catfish. Back Bay National Wildlife Refuge was established in 1938 to provide habitat for migrating and wintering waterfowl. Its unique geographic location along the Atlantic Coast provides overlapping ranges for both northern and southern species of birds. To help guests access the bay, Indian Cove Resort offers boat rentals and a boat ramp.

But the water and ocean isn't all there is to the resort. Enjoy swimming in one of three pools, pick up a game of horseshoes or shuffleboard, or relax at the recreation hall. Meet new friends at the many organized activities such as cookouts, flea markets, and arts and crafts. The channel that abuts the resort is also a huge source of recreation for visitors to Indian Cove Resort. In addition to fishing there's kayaking, paddleboats, and canoes, and these can be "borrowed" from the resort free of charge.

If you've arrived without your rig, don't worry. Choose from

various sized trailers, a three-bedroom cottage, and one-bedroom bungalow. The newest rental is a trailer with one queen bed, four bunk beds, and a dinette and couch that convert to beds.

Forgot something? Don't worry. The camp store has what you need in addition to beer, groceries, and fishing bait.

Each time you visit you can't help but notice that the resort is always improving. The resort website includes an Indian Cove Resort Five Year Plan.
