## A resort where strangers become friends and friends become family

If you've visited Eagles Resort in Grove, Oklahoma, prior to 2015, then you owe it to yourself to visit again because it's under new ownership. The owners have made many upgrades, including a new beach entry pool, one of the largest of its kind in the region, which was added in 2016.

There's plenty of choices of sites including pull-throughs and partial and full hook-up sites. If you choose to travel without your rig, then choose from many one-bedroom, two-bedroom, and one two-bedroom suites that are fully equipped cabins located on Grand Lake O' the Cherokees.

The resort is located near great restaurants, unique shopping, and a choice of casinos. Onsite amenities include an 18-hole mini-golf course, horseshoes, playground, pickle-ball court, soccer, kayaking, game room and theatre. Forget something? Replenish supplies at the country store. Catch the big one at the fishing pond and use the heated fishing dock and fish cleaning station. Pull your boat into one of the boat slips and use the ramp to put in. You can also store your boat or your RV at the resort.

One of the extra amenities is the proximity to the Grand Lake O' the Cherokees—a big lake covering 46,500 acres with a lot to offer. There are five state parks around the winding, scenic shoreline, as well as all the privately operated commercial marinas, restaurants, and fishing guides.

Native fish species found in the Grand Lake include large-mouth bass, white bass, channel catfish, crappie, bluegill and prehistoric spoonvill.

From Eagles Landing, guests are treated to an enchanting view of the lighted 3,044-foot long, four-lane New Sailboat Bridge. Completed in 2001, it is the second largest bridge over water in Oklahoma. This new bridge replaced the original Sailboat Bridge, a two-lane structure which curved upward in a parabolic arch and was 40 feet higher in the center. The original Sailboat Bridge, completed in 1939, received national recognition from the American Institute of Steel Construction.
