A stay at Kalamazoo Resort in Kalamazoo, Michigan, gives you three water options. Stroll around the pond or access Barbour Lake where you can rent paddle boats, wade, or swim. There are two docks to make it easier to launch your own flotation device or cast your bait and hopefully catch the big one. Lounge on the sandy shore or organize a beach volleyball game.

Of course, if you prefer big water, go offsite in under an hour to Lake Michigan, the third largest of the Great Lakes and the only one located entirely within the United States. The soft, white sand is known as singing sands because of the squeaking noise it makes when you walk on it.

Once at your tree-covered spacious site you'll feel secure with the 24-hour security. Set up at your spacious site and either put up your lawn chairs or go exploring. You could start your exploration at the All Seasons Lodge. Gather with friends and family around the flat-screen TV, sit in front of a roaring fire, or enjoy a pickup basketball game. And there's more. The activities department will keep you busy with a variety of interesting activities, including live entertainment. Pick up firewood and eat s'mores to your heart's content. There's also puttputt, a playground, and an

outdoor pool. If you need to add to your pantry, shop at the general store.

Offsite, golfers can tee it up with nearly two-dozen courses within an hour of downtown Kalamazoo. There are plenty of places where you can take a walk.

The former Kalamazoo and South Haven Railroad track bed has been converted to a trail system. Portage Creek Bicentennial Park features more than 8 miles of hiking / biking trails along Portage Creek. A visit to the Kalamazoo Nature Center offers 13 trails covering more than 10 miles of varied habitats from ponds to prairies, ferns and forest.
