Downtown Cheney is the region's gateway to the Columbia Plateau Trail and the Fish Lake Trail, both of which explore the unique geology of the Great Ice Age Floods.

If you must go offsite, head to nearby Spokane where you'll find the best shopping on the sunny side of Washington State. For a thrilling view of the area, take the gondola skyride above the raging Spokane River.

For hiking or biking, check out the Centennial Trail,

which is a 31.3-mile point-to-point trail located near Spokane. It features a lake and is accessible for all skill levels. The trail offers a number of activity options and is open year-round. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.
