Nearby Cape Henlopen State Park has a long list of things to entice you including ocean fishing from a pier, swimming, hiking the nature trails and climbing a real World War II observation tower. Rev it up a notch at the Rehoboth Beach boardwalk with its amusement rides, eateries and special events.

Amenities at Leisure Point Resort include the clubhouse, an outdoor swimming pool, a boat ramp, a marina store, a snack bar, a picnic area, playgrounds and an outdoor pavilion. There's even a marina that's accessible by boat from both the Atlantic Ocean and Delaware Bay. Float your boat right on in, and they'll rent you one of the 319 boat slips.
