



Lost Valley Lake Resort

The first indication that Lost Valley Lake is among the best can be found by visiting their Web site, www.lostvalleylake.com. A quick glance at the selection buttons shows the wide array of facilities and amenities you'll enjoy when you visit. Among the listings are the aquatic center, which features two pools, two spas and a kiddie pool, all heated for year-around use. There's even a handicapped-accessible shower facility.

Then there's the 21,000-square-foot sports arena where you'll find the activities office, an adult lounge, an arcade, a movie theater, miniature golf, shuffleboard and indoor basketball and volleyball courts. There's a boathouse, serving several lakes on the property that offer fishing, trolling, canoeing, sailing and just about anything else you'd do on a lake. Tennis courts, the wonderful Creekside Café, a driving range and a par-three golf course are on the long list of amenities.

At Lost Valley Lake, you'll find 537 acres of verdant rolling hills, each one of them spectacular. Day-trip destinations include Six Flags St. Louis, Meramec Caverns and the German village of Hermann, famous for its Maifest and Oktoberfest.

Lost Valley Lake Resort has 150 full-hookup sites and 80 partials, with a maximum RV length of 70 feet. Year-round operations put these facilities to good use.
